On the east face of the plinth:

BROMLEY, SCULPTOR
LEEDS & HALIFAX

NOTES

This is an obelisk tomb erected on a ledger. The obelisk itself has fallen from its plinth and is lying to the east. Of the obelisk's 3 visible sides, only 2 are dressed. The memorial inscription is, presumably, on the hidden side. Alfred Bromley operated from the Steam Marble Works in Saville St, Leeds (opposite the station) from 1852.
